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Single Activity Focus: Passport Christmas Yr1







Activity Overview

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| Description | A pretend passport, that we have put together, is stamped each time the children progress from one small group to the next and forms one part of the story to the next. It helps us think about journeys as we make one of our own. We will be considering the journey of Mary and Joseph, the shepherds and the wise men. |
| Year Group | Year 1 |
| Why use it | Having movement in storytelling is brilliant, especially for this age group. Kinaesthetic learning. |
| Duration | Task should not take very long ... 15 seconds per child |
| Size of group | Up to 10 children in each small group. |
| Resources | Script below printed off, mic. |
| More Information | Have a volunteer adult helper (or two) at the front doing the actions for everyone to follow. |
| Instructions | Copy, paste and resize image below onto A4 card. Two images per sheet then print. One per child. Stamps (a star if you can get it) Ask the children to put their name and class in the fields provided. Stamp their first small group/location, then explain that each time they move on, their passport will be stamped again. We find this helps to encourage the children's focus while they move round. Offers repetition and structure. Thereafter get into the rhythm of cue up, stamp passport, sit down, start telling the next story. |
